

DAILY COVID SYMPTOM SCREENING

BEFORE coming to campus each day students, staff, and any others coming to campus must complete the following screening:

1. Do you have new* symptoms of:
 - Fever (over 100 degrees or feeling feverish)
 - Shortness of breath
 - Moderate to severe cough
 - Diarrhea or vomiting
 - Sore throat
2. Do you have two of any of these symptoms:
 - Abdominal pain
 - Severe headache
 - Loss of taste or smell
3. Have you had close or household contact in the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 or who has COVID-19 symptoms but has not been tested or gotten an alternate diagnosis? (*see EOP for detailed definition of “close contact”*)
4. Have you traveled internationally by airplane in the past 14 days?

If you answered YES to any of the above, contact AHOS and follow self-quarantine and school exclusion guidelines. We encourage you to seek medical advice and self-quarantine at home unless cleared by a medical provider.

By coming to campus, you are assuring BMS Administration that you have completed this screening and had no “yes” answers. If you are unsure how to answer a question, contact the HOS. BMS may ask you to confirm screening any time on campus, and also immediately request that staff members screen themselves if needed.

*New” refers to symptoms unexplained by a chronic or other diagnosis; for conditions that present these symptoms, please submit documentation from a physician that there is a history of these symptoms and that they are not believed to be COVID related.
